Chairman Hancock being absent attending Ozark Trail at Amarillo.


The meeting was duly called to order by Mr. McLean, Acting Chairman, and the following business was transacted.

The following proceedings were transacted in the Minutes of the thirteenth and adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of June 27th and should have been written up with above minutes:

BE IT ORDERED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION: That the continuous Highway from a point about six miles North of Denison; thence to Denison; thence to Dallas; thence to Houston; thence to Galveston, be designated as the Henry Exall Memorial Highway, being described as follows:

Being part of Highway Number Six heretofore adopted by the Commission between point on State Line North of Denison; thence to Denison; thence to Dallas, and all of Highway heretofore adopted by Commission, and designated as Highway Number Fourteen and that part of Highway Number Two heretofore adopted by the Commission between Houston and Galveston, said Highway being a continuous Highway through the State and traversing the following counties:

Grayson, Collin, Dallas, Ellis, Navarro, Freestone, Leon, Madison, Walker or Grimes, Montgomery, Harris, Galveston.
