The meeting was duly called to order by Mr. Hancock, Chairman, and the following proceedings were had.

Be it resolved that Highway No. 12 be more particularly defined in part thereof as follows:

Beginning at Kingsville; thence to Riviera in Kleberg County; thence in a southwestwardly direction to Falfurrias; thence in a southerly direction to Edinburg in Hidalgo County; thence in a general southerly and southeastwardly direction to Brownsville.

Bond in the sum of \$20,000 for Geo. A. Duren, Engineer of the Department, was duly approved by the Commission July 3rd, 1917.

Matters of general interest and the regular routine of business was transacted.

No further business coming before the Commission, adjournment was taken until Thursday July 5th, 10 o'clock A.M.
