

STATE CAPITOL
July 17, 1917.

Minutes of the ninth and adjourned Second Regular Monthly Meeting of the STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hancock, and the following proceedings were had:

A delegation from Mexia, headed by Hon. D. L. Harp, Attorney, of Mexia, Texas, as spokesman, introduced a resolution that No. 14, now known as the Henry Exall Highway, be redesignated beginning at Corsicana, via Richmond, Curry, Wortham, Mexia, Groesbeck, Thornton, Kosse and Bremond; thence over the Highway heretofore designated as Highway No. 2 to Galveston.

A motion was made by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that the resolution be adopted. Motion carried.

A delegation from Burnett, Llano, Mason and Brady, headed by Mr. J. H. McLain from Llano, presented claims asking that the Road leading from Austin to Brady, via Burnet, Llano and Mason be designated as a State Highway. Mr. W. E. Long, Secretary of the Chamber of Commerce, addressed the Commission in behalf of Llano, Burnett, Mason and Brady for the extension of Highway No. 20.

A motion was made by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that the petition be granted and that No. 20 be extended via Burnett, Llano, Mason and Brady. Motion carried.

No further business coming before the Commission, adjournment was taken until Wednesday July 18th, 1917.
