October 9, 1917.

Minutes of the Second and Adjourned FIFTH
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING of the State Highway Department,
held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment.
The following members were present:

CURTIS HANCOCK, Chairman,
THOS. R. McLEAN,
H. C. ODLE.

The following business was transacted:

Hon. W. W. Searcy, et al, of Washington county
requested Federal Aid for the purpose of building a
bridge across the Brazos River, on Highway No. 20, and
the suggestion was made by the Commission that applica-
tions be made by Washington and Waller counties jointly,
for Aid in the construction of said bridge. No further
action was taken pending the consideration of the appli-
cations to be filed.

Hon. R. J. Windrow, County Engineer and Mr.
Burton, County Commissioner, of McLennan county pre-
sented petitions for Federal Aid. Motion by Mr. Mc-
Lean, seconded by Mr. Odle, that \$12,500 Federal Aid
be appropriated on Highway No. 2, Meridian Road, on
what is known as the "China Springs" end; \$12,500 on
Highway No. 2, Galveston Division; \$5,000 on Central
Texas Highway No. 7. Motion carried.

Adjournment was taken until 2:00 P. M.

Hon. W. L. Hill, et al, of Huntsville, present-
ed petitions and requested the designation of a State
Highway from Corsicana to Huntsville. Motion by Mr.
McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that the designation be
granted from Corsicana via Fairfield, Buffalo, Center-
ville, Madisonville and thence to Huntsville. Motion
carried.

Mr. Jack Witt, County Engineer, from Dallas
county, presented petition for Federal Aid, and on the
motion of Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean, Federal
Aid was granted on Highway No. 16, to the limit of the
law, not to exceed \$10,200.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean
that Federal Aid be granted on Highway No. 14, Dallas
county, according to the law, not to exceed \$10,000,
to be used from the city limits to and across Millers
Bridge. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean,
that State Aid be granted on Highway No. 15, in Dallas
county, not to exceed \$3000.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Hancock,
that petition for Aid on Richardson and Lancaster Road
be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean, that Federal Aid be granted on Highway No. 1, in Dallas county, not to exceed \$10,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that Highway No. 22 be more specifically designated via Fleming, Energy, Hamilton, Cranfills Gap, and Meridian, thence via Ferguson Ranch buildings, Chase and Whitney Bridge over the Brazos River. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that Highway No. 20 be designated from Austin via Jolleyville, Cedar Park, Leander, Liberty Hill and Bertram to Burnet. Motion carried.
