November 19, 1917.

Minutes of the SIXTH REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING of the STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present:

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, the minutes of the October meetings were read and approved, and the following business was transacted:

Hon. W. W. Searcy of Brenham asked the Commission for an extension of time to qualify for AID on the BRAZOS BRIDGE, HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY ~~for~~ WASHINGTON and WALLER counties. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted MORRIS COUNTY not to exceed \$15,100 between Omaha and CASS COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted NOLEN COUNTY not to exceed \$22,000, beginning at the TAYLOR COUNTY line and extending five miles east on HIGHWAY NUMBER ONE and from the west line of the NOLEN and MITCHELL COUNTY line extend east eight and one-half miles.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted NOLEN COUNTY not to exceed \$7,500 on HIGHWAY NUMBER ONE. Motion carried.

Mr. McLean in the Chair.

Motion by Mr. Hancock seconded by Mr. Odle that STATE AID be granted EASTLAND COUNTY not to exceed \$11,000. Motion carried.

Mr. Hancock in the Chair.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted EASTLAND COUNTY not to exceed \$35,000 between Ranger and CALLAHAN COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted FRANKLIN COUNTY not to exceed \$25,000 between TITUS COUNTY line and the HOPKINS COUNTY line on HIGHWAY NUMBER ONE. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted COMAL COUNTY not to exceed \$17,500 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO from HAYS COUNTY line to GUADALUPE COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted BEJAR COUNTY not to exceed \$50,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO between Selma and MEDINA COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted BEJAR COUNTY not to exceed \$5,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted ROBERTSON COUNTY not to exceed \$25,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO, Galveston division. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted TITUS COUNTY not to exceed \$39,920 on HIGHWAY NUMBER ONE; 28,020 between FRANKLIN COUNTY line, 9,900 between Mt. Pleasant and CAYP COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted HARRIS COUNTY not to exceed \$50,000 north of Houston and \$25,000 south of Houston on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO, Galveston division. Motion carried.

The Commission adjourned until 2:00 P. M.

Chairman Hancock stated to the committees representing GONZALES and HARWOOD routes that each would be given ten minutes to speak in behalf of their respective routes. Mr. W. J. Meininger spoke for the HARWOOD route and Mr. Rainbolt spoke for the GONZALES route, after which the Commissioners cast their ballots on paper, which read as follows:

For Gonzales,
For Harwood,
For neither.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that a Highway be designated from FORT WORTH to EMNIS via Kennedale, Mansfield, Midlothian, Britton, Sardis, Waxahachie to Emnis. Motion carried. Messrs. Odle and McLean voting "yes", Mr. Hancock voting "no."

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that an inter-county highway be designated from AUSTIN via Dripping Springs, Johnson City, Hye and Stonewall to FREDERICKSBURG. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that the MIDDLEBUSTER NUMBER TWENTY-NINE be more definitely designated via Yoakum. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean seconded by Mr. Odle that application be granted for the designation of the highway from RED RIVER over NUMBER FIVE ROAD to Paris, thence to Deport, Johnstown, Tulco, Mt. Pleasant, Daingerfield, Hughes Springs, Avinger, Jefferson and intersecting the East Texas Highway, traversing same to Carthage, thence to Timpson, to Garrison, crossing the KING'S HIGHWAY at Macogdoches, thence to Lufkin, Livingston, intersecting the JEFFERSON DAVIS MEMORIAL in LIBERTY COUNTY, traversing same to Houston, thence to Galveston. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted RANDALL COUNTY not to exceed \$4,317.50 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINE between POTTER COUNTY line to eleven miles south of Canyon. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted HOUSTON COUNTY not to exceed \$30,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY-ONE between nine miles east of Crockett to CHEROKEE COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted DONLEY COUNTY not to exceed \$16,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER THIRTEEN, between COLLINGSWORTH COUNTY line to four miles north of Hadley and six miles north of Clarendon. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted LAMAR COUNTY not to exceed \$12,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FIVE. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted LAMAR COUNTY not to exceed \$7,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINETEEN. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted SMITH COUNTY not to exceed \$16,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FIFTEEN. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted OLDHAM COUNTY not to exceed \$1885.00 on HIGHWAY NUMBER THIRTEEN between DEAR SMITH COUNTY line to ten miles east. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted JEFFERSON COUNTY not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER THREE between Beaumont and LIBERTY COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted HEMPHILL COUNTY not to exceed \$17,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FOUR between WHEELER COUNTY line and HIRSCOMB COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted WHEELER COUNTY not to exceed \$35,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FOUR. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted RANDÉLL COUNTY not to exceed \$11,800 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINE between POTTER COUNTY line and Canyon. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted BELL COUNTY not to exceed \$50,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO between Bartlett and FALLS COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted JASPER COUNTY not to exceed \$30,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT between KERBYVILLE and ERIN, HORTON and BROWDELL. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted JASPER COUNTY not to exceed \$10,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted JEFFERSON COUNTY not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT between Beaumont and Fort Arthur. Motion carried.
