November 20, 1917.

Minutes of the SECOND and ADJOURNED SIXTH REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING of the STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present:

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT be re-designated to follow the railroad as closely as possible between the cities of Jasper and San Augustine. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that petition more specifically designate NUMBER SEVEN via Waco, McGregor, Oglesby, Gatesville, Arnett, Evant, Starr, Center City, Goldthwaite, Mullen, Zephyr, Brownwood, Santa Anna, Coleman, Valeria, Talpa, Benoit, Ballinger, Rowena, Miles to San Angelo. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that application for intercounty highway designation from Temple to Goldthwaite be designated as follows: Via Belton, Holanville, Killeen, Copperas Cove, Kempner, Lampasas, Lometa to Goldthwaite.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that JEFFERSON DAVIS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY NUMBER TWELVE be designated from Victoria via Present Bridge, Tivola, Austwell, Lamar, Fulton, Rockport, Aransas Pass, Gregory, Portland to Corpus Christi. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that an intercounty highway be designated from Brady to Llano via Avoca, Fredonia, Pontatoc, Field Creek, Valley Springs to Llano. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that the two routes known as the SAU&G and the SA&AP between San Antonio and Corpus Christi be officially designated. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that the resolution offered by the STATE FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION for the adoption of certain roads as "State Fire Roads" be adopted. (See copy of resolution on file.) Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted COOKE COUNTY subject to approval not to exceed \$4,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER SIXTEEN between Red River and Gainesville to DENTON COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted Morris county not to exceed \$17,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER ONE between Titus county line and CASS county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted Gillespie County not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINE between MASON county line and Fredericksburg. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that STATE AID be granted SABINE county not to exceed \$7,500 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted SABINE COUNTY not to exceed \$18,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT, SABINE to St. AUGUSTINE COUNTY line through Brooklyn. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted CASS COUNTY not to exceed \$25,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER ONE, between Sulphur River and MORRIS COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted GALVESTON COUNTY not to exceed limit by law on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWO. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted FORD COUNTY not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY-EIGHT between North Wichita River and to COTTE COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted CHEROKEE COUNTY not to exceed \$5,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER SEVEN. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted CHEROKEE COUNTY not to exceed \$30,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY-TWO between county line and county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted COKE COUNTY not to exceed \$5,600 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FOUR. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted COKE COUNTY not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FOUR between NOLAN COUNTY line and TOM GREEN COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted CASS COUNTY not to exceed \$25,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT between Douglassville and MARION COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted HENDERSON COUNTY not to exceed \$30,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINETEEN between Van SANDT and ANDERSON COUNTY line when proper petition is presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted ANDERSON COUNTY not to exceed \$30,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINETEEN between county line north and to county line south. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted ANDERSON COUNTY not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY-TWO between county line and county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted McCulloch county not to exceed \$35,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINE between MASON county line and CONCHO COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted McCULLOCH COUNTY not to exceed \$15,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TEN between county line and county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted CALHOUN COUNTY not to exceed \$10,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY-NINE between Port Lavaca and VICTORIA COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean seconded by Mr. Odle that STATE AID be granted ORANGE COUNTY not to exceed \$9,750 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT between Buna Road and Texla Junction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle that FEDERAL AID be granted ORANGE COUNTY not to exceed \$10,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER EIGHT between Buna Road and Texla Junction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted MASON COUNTY not to exceed \$11,266.75 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINE between Mason Postoffice and GILLESPIE COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted HARDEN COUNTY not to exceed \$2,025 on HIGHWAY NUMBER FIVE. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean that FEDERAL AID be granted KENDALL COUNTY not to exceed \$21,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER NINE, when proper petition is presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle seconded by Mr. McLean that STATE AID be granted KENDALL COUNTY not to exceed the limit on ten mile highway. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, adjournment was taken until Wednesday morning, November 21st.
