Minutes of the FOURTH and ADJOURNED SIXTH REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING of the STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT. The following members were present:

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the following business was transacted:


Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that forms for intercounty highway designations as per copy on file in the Engineering Department be adopted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that FEDERAL AID be granted LIBERTY COUNTY not to exceed \$20,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER THREE between JEFFERSON COUNTY line and LIBERTY COUNTY line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that STATE AID be granted LIBERTY COUNTY not to exceed \$5,000 on HIGHWAY NUMBER THREE. Motion carried.

Matters referred to the Commission by the Engineer were not disposed of and were referred back to him for disposal.

There being no further business to be transacted, the Commission adjourned to meet in Denison on the 23rd inst.
