Minutes of the Fourth and adjourned Seventh Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Department, held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present:

The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that State Aid be granted Caldwell county not to exceed limit on Highway No. 29. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that Highway No. 18 be extended from Albany via Sedwick, Maron, Pueblo to Cisco and at that point it shall take the place of No. 36 to Waco and said No. 36 shall be abandoned. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Odle, seconded by Mr. Hancock that an intercounty highway be designated from San Angelo paralleling the Orient Railroad via Rankin to Fort Stockton. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that Federal Aid be granted Caldwell county not to exceed \$35,000 on Highway No. 29 between Travis county line and Gonzales. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hancock, seconded by Mr. Odle that Federal Aid be granted Guadalupe county not to exceed \$5,000 on Highway No. 2 between Comal county and Bexar county line. Motion carried.

The Commission adjourned until Tuesday morning, December 22nd.
