Minutes of the Third and Adjourned Regular Monthly Session of the State Highway Commission held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present:

Curtis Hancock, Chairman,
R. M. Hubbard, Commissioner of Construction,
J. E. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration, Absent,
Geo. A. Duren, State Highway Engineer.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that an inter-county designation be made as follows: Beginning at Cisco, thence to Scranton in Eastland County, thence to Cottonwood, thence to Cross Plains, thence to Burkett, thence to Echo, thence to Coleman. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Callahan County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 1 beginning at Baird, thence west 10.1 miles, and beginning at Eastland County, thence west two miles, be granted not to exceed the sum of \$25,226.85. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Callahan County for State Aid on Highway No. 1 beginning at Baird, thence east ten miles, be granted not to exceed \$11,416.12. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Callahan County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 23 beginning at Baird, thence south 2.7 miles, be granted not to exceed the sum of \$6,916.80. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Limestone County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 14 from county line to county line be granted not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Limestone County for State Aid be granted on ten miles of Highway No. 14, not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Fisher County for State Aid be granted not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars on Highway No. 4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock that the application of Fisher County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 4 from county line south to district line north, be granted not to exceed Twenty Five Thousand Dollars. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Van Sandt County for State Aid on Highway No. 15 be granted to the limit allowed by law, not to exceed \$21,500. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Van Sandt County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 15 from county line west to county line east be granted not to exceed Forty Thousand Dollars. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Van Zandt County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 19 from county line north to county line south, be granted not to exceed \$18,500. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of San Patricio County for aid on Highway No. 12 from county line to county line, be granted out of State Aid not to exceed \$13,398. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of San Patricio County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 12 from county line to county line be granted not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Aransas County for State Aid from the San Patricio County line ten miles north to Rockport on Highway No. 12, be granted out of State Aid not to exceed \$13,841.88. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Aransas County for Federal Aid on Highway No. 12, beginning at the San Patricio County line, thence north to Rockport, be granted not to exceed \$13,841.88. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of Rockwall County for Aid on Highway No. 1 from county line to county line, be granted out of Federal Aid not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars. Motion carried.
