

March 18th, 1918.

Minutes of the Tenth Regular Meeting of the State Highway Commission held at the Capitol Building on the 18th day of March, pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present:

Curtis Hancock, Chairman,
R. M. Hubbard, Commissioner of Construction,
J. G. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration,
George A. Duren, State Highway Engineer.

The Commission was called to order by the Chairman, and the following business transacted:

Minutes of February meetings were read and adopted.

Motion by Mr. Fowler seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the applications from HARRIS COUNTY be granted out of STATE AID to the limit of the law, not to exceed \$35,000. Motion carried. (No. 3.)

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the application of LIMESTONE COUNTY for FEDERAL AID in the sum of \$135,000 on Number 7 be taken under advisement. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the matter of more definitely locating HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY ONE be referred to Mr. Fowler for action to be reported on later. Motion carried.

Upon report of Mr. Fowler on the matter of more definitely locating HIGHWAY NUMBER TWENTY ONE, it was moved by Mr. Fowler and seconded by Mr. Hubbard that the application for a more definite designation of Highway Number Twenty One between Gonzales and Karnes City through Bebe, Leesville and Nixon, be granted as prayed for. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the application of HAYS COUNTY be granted out of STATE AID on Highway Number Two in the sum of \$10,787.50. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the application of COMAL COUNTY for STATE AID on Highway Number Two be granted not to exceed \$8,750.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the application of JASPER COUNTY for STATE AID on Highway Number Seven be granted not to exceed the sum of \$10,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the application of JASPER COUNTY for FEDERAL AID on Highway Number Seven be granted not to exceed \$30,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the application of DALLAS COUNTY for STATE AID on Highway Number One from the City of Dallas to the Tarrant County line be granted, not to exceed \$50,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the county allotments to the county treasurers from the State Highway Department as of March 1, 1918, as shown by the accompanying allotments, be passed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the application signed by Judge O'Bryant, County Judge of Bandera County, be granted that Highway Number 27 be extended from Fort Stockton; thence along Highway Number 10 to Sonora; thence to Junction City; thence to Mountain Home; thence to Ingram; thence to Kerrville; thence to Camp Verde; thence to Bandera; thence to Pipe Creek thence to Helotes; thence to San Antonio. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the application of BANDERA COUNTY for STATE AID on Highway Number 27 be granted to the limit of the law, covering that portion of the road from Bandera south east. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the application of DENTON COUNTY for FEDERAL AID on Highway Number 16 be granted from Denton to Tarrant County line, not to exceed the sum of \$17,631.90. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the application of VICTORIA COUNTY for additional STATE AID on Highway Number 29 not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars on the project, be granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the petition of COKE COUNTY requesting STATE AID to the amount of fifty per cent on Highway Number Four from Robert Lee to a point ten miles south, be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the petition of LAMAR COUNTY for transferring the allotments of Aid granted from Number Five to Number Nineteen and vice versa, be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the application of LIMESTONE COUNTY for FEDERAL AID on Number Seven be reconsidered, and be granted out of Federal Aid not to exceed \$15,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the petition of STONEWALL County requesting substitution of STATE AID for FEDERAL AID on proposed bridge construction across Highway Number 28, Salt Fork of Brazos, be deferred. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that the minutes be corrected as follows:

✓ RANDALL COUNTY: Minutes of November should be amended to include the Federal Aid on eleven miles south of Canyon.

WARD COUNTY: Minutes, page 105, should have aid allotted on Highway Number 17 instead of on Number One. (Federal.)

HARRIS COUNTY: Minutes of November 19, 1917 should have State Aid in the sum of \$15,000 allotted on ten miles of highway in Harris County.


Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that the Newton County proposition for changing the location of Highway Number 7 be deferred until next meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that action on the extension of Number 12 from Victoria to Palfurrias, via Refugio, Sinton, Odem, Callalen, Bluntzer, Banquete, and Alice, be deferred. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that an application for designation of route be granted from Livingston, to Camilla, Cold Springs, Evergreen, Maynard, to New Waverly, and that the State Highway be known as Number 35-A. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Hubbard, that an inter-county highway be granted, beginning at Cameron; thence to Milano; thence to Caldwell; thence to Somerville; thence to Brenham. Motion carried.

The Commission adjourned until March 19th.
