

July 17, 1918.

Minutes of the Third and Adjourned Fourteenth Regular Session of the State Highway Commission held at the Capitol pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present:

Curtis Hancock, Chairman,
R. M. Hubbard, Commissioner of Construction,
J. G. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration, Absent,
George A. Duren, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of the citizens of Georgetown for designation of highway from Austin via Fiskville, Round Rock, Georgetown, Jarrell, Prairie Dell, Salado, Belton to Temple, to be known as 2-C of the Meridian Road, be granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of HAYS County for Federal Aid on Highway Number Two, beginning at a bridge on the San Marcos River, thence along Government Fish Hatchery, continuing to intersection of Cedar and Colorado Street, be granted out of Federal Aid not to exceed the sum of \$658.50. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the application of CHEROKEE County for an increase in State Aid on forty miles of the Jim Hogg Highway be increased from \$30,000 to the sum of \$40,000, said amount not exceeding one fourth of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the Highway Engineer be authorized to purchase a Ford automobile for the use of the Department. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the State Aid heretofore granted to Nolan County on Highway Number One to the extent of one fourth of the contract, shall be more specifically allotted to the extent of one fourth of the contract, not to exceed the sum of \$13,516.59. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Hancock, that the following revisions be made in the pay roll. Motion carried.
