

May 20, 1919.

Minutes of the Second and adjourned Twenty-Fourth Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman of the Commission,
C. N. Avery, Commissioner of Construction,
C. S. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration,
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that McLennan county be granted \$40,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 6, between Waco and the McLennan county line north. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Washington county be granted \$200,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that the Federal Aid in the amount of \$25,226.85 heretofore granted Callahan county on Highway No. 1, under date of February 4, 1918 be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the State Aid in the amount of \$11,416.12 heretofore granted Callahan county on Highway No. 1, be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Callahan county be granted \$75,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 1, from county line to county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Wharton county be granted \$20,250 Federal Aid on State Highway No. 3, beginning at the Fort Bend county line, and extending west 5.9 miles. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Wharton county be granted \$20,250 State Aid on Highway No. 3, beginning at a point 5.9 miles west of the Fort Bend county line, thence west to the Colorado county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that \$40,500 be deducted from the former grant of \$200,000 Federal Aid to Wharton county, leaving available for that county \$159,000, conditioned upon the passage of the proposed \$2,000,000 bond issue. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Somervell county be granted \$40,000 Federal Aid on Highways Nos. 25 and 10-a, Road District No. 1, conditioned on the passage of a \$60,000 bond issue. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Highway No. 1, between the points of Sulphur Springs and Greenville be more definitely designated as follows: Beginning at Sulphur Springs, thence to Ridgeway, thence to Commerce, thence to Meyland, thence to Greenville, conditioned that all grade crossings be eliminated except the one a mile west of Commerce. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Bexar county be granted \$6,752.06 additional Federal Aid on the south end of Highway No. 2. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Bexar county be granted \$10,702.59 Federal Aid on the East part of Highway No. 2. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Bexar county be granted \$35,802.33 Federal Aid on the North end of Highway No. 9. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that all State and Federal Aid heretofore granted Comanche county be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Comanche county be granted \$66,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 10 from county line to county line.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Comanche county be granted \$34,000 State Aid on Highway No. 22. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Guadalupe county be granted \$50,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 3, from Seguin to the county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that all former grants to Denton county be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Denton county be granted \$200,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Ellis county be granted \$100,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 14, not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that the \$6,250 State Aid granted Harris county on State Highway No. 19, on January 21, 1919 be transferred to State Highway No. 3-a, beginning at Hillendahls, thence west to the Harris county line, making a total of \$12,500 on said project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Guadalupe county be granted \$50,000 Federal Aid, conditioned upon the county providing 50 per cent of the cost of constructing State Highway No. 2, through Guadalupe county. If such is not provided, then the amount required to build said Highway No. 2 shall be deducted from the \$50,000 previously granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Hale county be granted \$150,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction and conditioned upon the passage of the proposed \$500,000 bond issue. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery, that Shackelford county be granted \$7,000 on Highway No. 1, not to exceed 50 per cent of the contract. Motion carried. (State Aid.)

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that the minutes of November 19th, 1917, granting \$15,000 State Aid to Harris county on ten miles of Highway No. 12, be changed to read as follows: Harris

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county granted one-fourth of the cost of constructing 4-1/4 miles of Highway No. 12, not to exceed \$6,000 and not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, adjournment was taken until the regular monthly meeting in June.
