Minutes of the Second and Twenty-fifth adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building with the following members present:

R. L. Hubbard, Chairman,  
C. N. Avery, Commissioner of Construction,  
C. S. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration,  
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the following Resolution be adopted:

"Whereas, it is made to appear to the State Highway Commission that the assessed valuation of the property of the county of Stonewall does not warrant the construction of the bridge across the Salt Fork of the Brazos River, on Highway No. 18, which bridge is a very important part of Highway No. 18, and it is necessary for the Commission to exercise discretion in increasing its allotment to the said Stonewall county not to exceed one-half the cost of constructing not more than ten miles of roadway in said county;

'Therefore, be it ordered by the Highway Commission that the discretion of the Commission is hereby exercised in the matter of Stonewall county's application for State Aid on the bridge across Salt Fork of the Brazos River, on Highway No. 18 in said county, and that in making allotment of State Aid in said county on said bridge, the Commission shall and is hereby authorized to make such allotment in the sum of \$3,300, not to exceed one-half the cost of construction of said bridge as provided in Section 12 of the State Highway Act."

Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that the application of Hood county for additional Aid on Highway No. 10 be rejected. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Bexar county be granted Federal Aid on the East Branch of the SA&AP Branch of Highway No. 9, in the amount of \$81,078.81, between the San Antonio and the Wilson county line. Motion carried.

The Commission adjourned and convened at 8:00 P. M., with the following members present:

The following business was transacted:


Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Highway No. 40 be more definitely designated from Denton to Fort Worth, via Roanoke; conditioned that a type of road similar to the balance of the road that will be constructed between Fort Worth and Denton on this Highway be properly financed by the Roanoke Road District, within six months from this date. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Red River county Road District No. 8 be granted \$20,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 5, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, adjournment was taken until Wednesday, June 18th.
