

March 15th, 1920.

Minutes of the Thirty-fourth and Adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R.M. Hubbard, Chairman,
C.N. Avery, Commissioner of Construction,
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer.

Mr. Fowler was unable to be present, due to business which took him out of the State.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Guadalupe County be granted \$25,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 3 from Seguin to the west county line, making a total of \$75,000 on this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that the \$25,000 Federal Aid granted Robertson County on Highway No. 2, Galveston Division be canceled. Motion carried. *Wue*

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Robertson County be granted \$25,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 14, not to exceed 50 per cent of the cost of construction, making a total of \$69,262 on Highway No. 14. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Calhoun County be granted \$30,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 29, to apply between Wittenberg Gate and a point about two miles east of Seadrift. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that the forty per cent limitation on the Federal Aid previously granted to Camp County be removed and the limitation placed at fifty per cent; conditioned that they build a permanent type of road, to meet the requirements of the State Highway Department. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that the \$20,000 Federal Aid previously granted Liberty County on Highway No. 3, between the Jefferson County line and the Liberty County line be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that the \$5,000 State Aid granted Liberty County on Highway No. 3, November 22nd, 1917, be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Liberty County be granted \$25,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 35 between the San Jacinto and Montgomery County lines, making a total of \$65,000 on this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Bastrop County be granted \$10,270 Federal Aid on State Highway No. 3-a, between Station 0 plus 87 and Station 121, a distance of 2.28 miles, in Road District No. 6. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Highway No. 10 from Fort Stockton to Alpine, thence to Marfa, thence to Valentine be discontinued. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Highway No. 10 be designated from Fort Stockton along the route of No. 28 to a point just east of the Reeves County line; thence through the Limpia Canyon to Fort Davis, thence to Valentine. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Highway No. 12 from Sanderson paralleling the Rio Grande River to Van Horn be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Highway No. 12 be designated from Sanderson to Marathon, thence to Alpine, thence to Marfa, thence to Valentine, thence to Van Horn. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that the condition imposed on the \$30,000 Federal Aid granted February 16, 1920 to Webb County be removed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that the State and Federal Aid previously granted to Victoria County be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that the minutes of the State Highway Commission be corrected to show that the \$12,271 Federal Aid granted to Tarrant County on Highway No. 1, between Fort Worth and the Parker County line had been increased to \$24,000 as shown by the minutes of September 15th, 1919. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Federal Aid Project No. 49 in Nolan County be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Falls County be granted \$70,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 2, not to exceed 50 per cent of the cost of construction, making a total granted out of Federal funds \$83,210.40. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that the \$162,000.00 Federal Aid granted to Erath County be applied to State Highway No. 10 from County line to County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Lamb County be granted \$16,666.65 State Aid, not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction of State Highway No. 7 from the Bailey County line to the Hockley County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Federal aid project No. 44 in Robertson county be annulled. Motion carried.
