

May 17, 1920. *new*

Minutes of the Thirty-sixth and Second Adjourned Regular Monthly meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman,
C. W. Avery, Commissioner of Construction,
C. S. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration,
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the 25 per cent clause in the minutes of May 19th, 1919, granting Johnson county \$200,000 Federal aid be eliminated. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that the Federal aid previously granted to Johnson county be apportioned as follows: \$100,000 on State Highway No. 2, from Cleburne to the Tarrant county line; \$100,000 on No. 2-A from the point of intersection of Highways Nos. 10 and 2-A to the Tarrant county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Milam county be granted \$18,185.48 Federal aid on Highway No. 44, making a total of \$32,685.48 allotted out of \$30,000 grant to this highways, leaving a balance of \$47,314.52. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the 25 per cent clause be eliminated from the minutes of June 18th and December 15th, 1919, granting Federal aid to Milam county. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that the 25 per cent clause contained in the minutes of April 23, 1919, granting Bastrop county Federal aid on Highway No. 20, be eliminated. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Falls county be granted \$3,252.40 additional Federal aid on State Highway No. 2 between Harlin and Reagan, making a total of \$3,252.40 granted this road out of Federal funds and that said \$3,252.40 is to be deducted from \$70,000 grant of March 16th, 1920. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Shackelford county be granted additional \$4,000.00 State aid on State aid project No. 3, making a total of \$18,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Wood county be granted \$17,500 additional Federal aid on Highway No. 37, for widening the surfacing, making a total of \$59,000.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Wood county be granted \$27,000 additional Federal aid on No. 15 from Lineola east to the county line for widening the surfacing, making a total of \$90,500.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Wood county be granted \$30,500 Federal aid on Highway No. 15 from Lineola west to the county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the \$50,000 Federal aid granted Kleburg county April 20, 1920, be increased by \$10,000, making a total grant to this county on State Highway No. 12 of \$185,000, said total grant to apply from the Nueces county line to the Brooks county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the \$40,000.00 Federal aid granted Montague County on Highway No. 5 be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Montague County be granted \$40,000 Federal aid on Highway 2-d, making a total of \$100,000 Federal aid to this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the inter-county highway designated January 23rd, 1918 beginning at Greenville and ending at Decatur, petition presented by Collin County, be canceled. Motion carried

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that San Augustine County be granted \$50,000 Federal aid on Highway No. 21 from the Nacogdoches county line to San Augustine. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Avery that Cass County be granted on Highway No. 1, in the Bryants Mill district \$12,487.05 additional Federal aid, making the total granted to this district out of Federal funds \$27,487.05. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Cass County be granted on Highway No. 1 in the Bryants Mill district \$16,486.70 additional State aid, making a total of \$34,486.70 out of State funds. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Hill County be granted \$25,000 State aid on Highway No. 2-a, making a total of \$50,000 on this highway out of State aid funds. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler, that Hill County be granted \$25,000.00 Federal aid on Highway No. 6 from Hillsboro to the Ellis county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the \$20,051.59 Federal aid previously granted Jefferson County on Highways Nos. 3 and 8 be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Jefferson County be granted \$69,000.00 additional Federal aid on Highway No. 8, making a total of \$169,000 out of Federal funds on this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Jefferson County be granted \$7,687.40 additional Federal aid on State Highway No. 3, making the total granted on this highway \$87,635.81. Motion carried.
