Minutes of the Forty-Third and First Adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman,
C. N. Avery, Commissioner of Construction,
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer.

Commissioner J. S. Fowler out of the State on business.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that the following route over the designated State highways concerned be hereby officially designated as "The Jefferson Davis National Highway:"

Beginning at the Louisiana State line on State Highway No. 3, and traversing same to Orange, Houston, Fort Bend and Saint Bernard; thence over No. 12 to Victoria and Goliad; thence over No. 3-B to Beeville; thence over No. 9 to Karnes City, Floresville and San Antonio; thence over No. 3 to Hondo, Sabin, Uvalde, Brackettsville and Del Rio; thence over No. 12 to Valentine; thence over No. 10 to Van Horn; thence over No. 1 to El Paso. From Valentine to Fort Davis over No. 10. From San Antonio to Austin over No. 2. From Beeville to Gregory over No. 9; thence to Brownsville over No. 12.

Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Wichita county be granted \$50,000 additional Federal aid on State Highway No. 5, Federal aid project 119, making a total of \$150,000 to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that the \$100,000 Federal aid to Eastland county granted April 20, 1920 be applied to State Highway No. 1 between Cisco and Ranger. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Wichita county be granted \$25,000 State aid on State Highway No. 5, being Federal aid project 119. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Calhoun county be granted \$634.10 State aid on State Highway No. 29, Job 29-B. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Franklin county be granted \$38,692.00 State aid on State Highway No. 1. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that \$23,178.11 of the \$71,870.11 Federal aid allotted to Franklin county on State Highway No. 1 be cancelled, leaving a balance of \$38,692.00 Federal aid to this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Cass county be granted \$23,000 additional Federal aid on State Highway No. 1 in the Douglasville District, Job No. 34-D, making a total of \$33,000.00 Federal aid to this portion of No. 1 in Cass county. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that El Paso county be granted \$125,238.88 additional State aid on State Highway No. 33, from El Paso north making a total of \$150,238.88 State aid to this portion of No. 33. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Gillespie county be granted \$10,439.78 additional State aid on State Highway No. 9, making a total of \$17,939.79. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that \$11,099.86 of the \$35,000 Federal aid allotted to State Highway No. 4 in Childress county be temporarily withdrawn. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that El Paso county be granted \$27,250.00 State aid on State Highway No. 33 east of El Paso. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Bosque county be granted \$14,076.72 additional State aid on State Highway No. 2, making a total of \$34,076.72 State aid to this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Brown county be granted \$5,372.72 additional State aid on State Highway No. 10, making a total of \$27,872.72 State aid to this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Falls county be granted \$1,000.00 State aid on the Galveston branch of State Highway No. 2, Job No. 74-B, Federal aid project No. 184. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that Brooks county be granted \$15,000 additional State aid on State Highway No. 12 from Encinal south to the Hidalgo county line, Job No. 24-B, making a total of \$30,000 State aid to this job, conditioned that alignment between Station 496+00 and Hidalgo county line be made satisfactory to the State Highway Department. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Hubbard that Falls county be granted \$2,143.16 State aid on the Laredo branch of No. 2, Job No. 74-A. Motion carried.



Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Rockwall county be granted \$85,312.80 State aid on State Highway No. 1. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Angelina county be granted \$24,062.50 State aid and \$24,062.50 Federal aid on State Highway No. 35 from Lufkin to the Angelina river. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Harrison county be granted \$15,532.19 Federal aid on State Highway No. 11, Federal aid project No. 142, making a total of \$215,532.19 aid on this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Harrison county be granted \$9,467.81 Federal aid on State Highway No. 8. Motion carried.
