Minutes of the Forty-Fifth and First Adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman,  
W. W. McCrory, Commissioner of Registration,  
D. K. Martin, Commissioner of Construction.  
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Jasper County be granted \$42,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 8 from Jasper north to Horton's Switch. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Jasper county be granted \$27,156.00 State aid on Highway No. 8, from Jasper north to Horton's Switch. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Texas Federal aid project No. 16 in McCulloch county be annulled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Federal aid project No. 209 in Red River county be annulled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the \$120,000 State aid granted Kleburg county on State Highway No. 12 be apportioned as follows: \$102,500 from the Nueces county line to Station 1036 plus 80 at Riveria and \$17,500 from Station 1036 plus 80 to the Brooks county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the \$185,000 Federal aid allotted to Kleburg county on State Highway No. 12 be apportioned as follows: \$166,800 from Nueces county line to Station 1036 plus 80 at Riveria, known as Section A of Texas Federal aid project No. 148; and \$18,200 from Station 1036 plus 80 to the Brooks county line, known as Section B of Texas Federal aid project No. 148. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Federal aid project No. 186 in Cottle county be annulled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the \$50,000 Federal aid allotted to Cottle county on State Highway No. 4 be cancelled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Orange county be granted \$25,000 State aid on State Highway No. 3, Federal aid project No. 149. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the two grants of \$15,000 and \$10,000 Federal aid each made to Orange county September 21st, 1920 be cancelled in lieu of the \$25,000 State aid granted on this date. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Webb county be granted \$10,000 State aid on State Highway No. 2 north. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory seconded by Mr. Martin that the State Highway Engineer be authorized to sign, for the members of the Commission, the project agreements between the Secretary of Agriculture and the State Highway Commission on all Texas Federal Aid Projects. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Van Zandt county be granted \$48,000 State aid on State Highway No. 15. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Madison county be granted \$11,378.22 State aid on State Highway No. 32, Federal aid project No. 51. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Freestone county be granted \$9,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 7, from the Limestone county line to 2.79 miles east of Teague, to be applied to topping. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Freestone county be granted \$522.94 State aid on State Highway No. 32, State aid project No. 122, from the line of Road District No. 8 to the Leon county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No. 5 in Red River county be more definitely located as follows: Beginning at Annona; thence northwest about one-half mile to a point on a line between the Russell and Wright properties,; thence in a northerly direction to the English-Clarksville gravel road. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Runnels county be granted \$2653.60 additional Federal aid on the Colorado River bridge, Federal aid project No. 107, making a total of \$39,135.39 Federal aid to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Runnels county be granted \$1326.80 additional State aid on the Colorado River bridge at Ballinger, State aid project No. 67, making a total of \$19,567.69 State aid to this project. Motion carried.
