

February 22, 1921.

Minutes of the Forty-Fifth and Second Adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman,
W. W. McCrory, Commissioner of Registration,
D. K. Martin, Commissioner of Construction,
Rollen J. Windrow, State Highway Engineer

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that State Highway No. 12-A be designated as follows: Beginning at Robstown; thence to Alice; thence to San Diego; thence to Hebronville; thence to Laredo. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Brazoria county be granted \$35,000 State aid on State Highway No. 36, Federal aid project No. 106, to apply to surfacing. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Travis county be granted \$12,000 State aid on State Highway No. 29. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Mason county be granted \$22,100 State aid on State Highway No. 9, present project, not to exceed 50 per cent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Mason county be granted \$4,500 Federal aid on State Highway No. 9, present project, not to exceed 50 per cent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Walker county be granted \$6,750 Federal aid on State Highway No. 32, county line bridge, between Walker and Madison counties. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Collin county be granted \$17,000 State aid on Section B, Federal aid project No. 98, State Highway No. 6, in the Allen district. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the designation of No. 18-A in Dickens county be changed to read as follows: Beginning at Spur and extending north to the town of Dickens, passing over the present gravel road, thence west from Dickens over the well-travelled road to Crosby. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the number of State Highway No. 12-A in Matagorda county be changed to 12-C. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Lamar county be granted \$8,487.10 additional State aid to apply on State Highway No. 19, State aid project No. 117. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Lamar county be granted \$25,816.39 State aid to apply on State Highway No. 5, Federal aid project No. 38. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Lamar county be granted \$15,696.51 additional State aid on State Highway No. 5, State aid project No. 116. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Guadalupe county be granted \$9,616.18 additional State aid on Federal aid project No. 155, Job No. 95-D, making a total of \$14,916.18 State aid to the project, provided the county constructs the section from Station 930 to 945, which is omitted in present plans.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the unused balance of \$99.19 Federal aid granted to Bosque county on State Highway No. 2 be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the minutes of November 24th, 1920, withdrawing \$100,000 Federal aid granted to Eastland county on State Highway No. 1 be rescinded. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the unapportioned balance of \$20,000 Federal aid on Job No. 60-C, in Delta county be temporarily withdrawn. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the unused balance of \$4488.08 State aid granted to Lamb county be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the minutes of October 19, 1920 whereby \$35,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 27 and \$125,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 1 in Reeves county were temporarily withdrawn be rescinded. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that \$10,000 of the \$35,000 Federal aid granted Reeves county March 19, 1919 on State Highway No. 27 be cancelled, leaving a balance of \$25,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the unused balance of the \$165,000 Federal aid, amounting to \$28,914.54, in Reeves county, State Highway No. 1, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the unused balance of \$5,327.21 of the \$41,507.12 Federal aid which was to apply to Federal aid project No. 118, State Highway No. 12 in Webb county be transferred to Highway No. 2, making a total of \$163,820.09 Federal aid to this Highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that \$80,000 of the \$163,820.09 Federal aid allotted to State Highway No. 2 in Webb county be cancelled and that \$80,000 State aid be granted in lieu thereof, making a total of \$90,000 State aid to this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the \$74,000 State aid granted Ward county April 19, 1920, on State Highway No. 1 be cancelled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the \$40,000 Federal aid granted Guadalupe county August 16, 1920, on State Highway No. 3, be cancelled. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that \$29,992.25 of the \$35,000 Federal aid granted to McCulloch county November 20th, 1917 and temporarily withdrawn June 22nd, 1920, be canceled, leaving a balance of \$5007.75, which is to apply on Federal aid project No. 223, Highway No. 9. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the unused balance of \$1,479.52 Federal aid of the \$6,476.52 allotted to the bridge over the Washita river in Hemphill county on September 20th, 1920 be cancelled, leaving a balance of \$4,797.00 Federal aid on this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the balance of \$29,395.00 Federal aid granted August 19, 1918 to Sabine county on State Highway No. 8-A from Hemphill to the Newton county line be temporarily withdrawn. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin \$30,864.65 State aid be allotted to Fayette county on State Highway No. 3-B from La Grange north to Oldenberg. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that \$30,864.65 of the \$116,000 Federal aid allotted to Fayette county August 18, 1919 be made to apply from La Grange north to Oldenburg on State Highway No. 3-B. Motion carried.
