Minutes of the Forty-Sixth and Second Adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Palo Pinto county be granted \$15,000 State aid on bridge over Strawn Creek on State Highway No. 1. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Johnson county be granted \$100,000 State aid on State Highway No. 2-A, to be applied to Federal aid project No. 181 and Federal aid project No. 228. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that \$25,000 of the Federal aid previously granted to Nueces county be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Nueces county be granted \$25,000 additional State aid. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the Federal aid previously granted to Nueces county be apportioned as follows: \$125,000 to the causeway and \$50,000 to State Highway No. 12 in the Bishop-Robstown district. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the State aid previously granted to Nueces county be apportioned as follows: \$75,000 to the causeway and \$50,000 to State Highway No. 12 in the Bishop-Robstown district. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Wheeler county be granted \$54,500 on bridge over Red River on State Highway No. 4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Wheeler county be granted \$37,500 State aid on bridge over Red River on State Highway No. 4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Shelby county be granted \$50,000 additional State aid on State Highway No. 22. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Hidalgo county be granted \$62,929.45 Federal aid on State Highway No. 12. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Hill county be granted \$60,000 State aid in the Itasca district, on State Highway No. 2-A, from Hillsboro to the county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Hill county be granted \$10,000 State aid on State Highway No. 6 in the Brandon District. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No. 2-E be designated, beginning at Cleburne; thence to Covington; thence to Itasca; and officially named the John Stephens Highway; conditioned that no aid be requested at the present time or in the future on this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that State Highway No. 39 be more definitely designated beginning at Decatur; thence to Bridgport; thence to Chico; thence to Jacksboro. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Bexar county be granted \$37,500 Federal aid on State Highway No. 2 from San Antonio to the Atascosa county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Bexar county be granted \$37,500 State aid on State Highway No. 2, from San Antonio to the Atascosa county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Bexar county be granted \$25,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 3 from San Antonio east. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that State Highway No. 35 be more definitely designated from Livingston to Cleveland, to parallel as nearly as possible the HE&WT Railway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Wichita county be granted \$100,000 additional State aid to be apportioned as follows: \$50,000 on State Highway No. 5, from Iowa Park to the Wilbarger county line; and \$50,000 on State Highway No. 2, from a point 6.2 miles north of Wichita Falls to Red River. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Knox county be granted \$6,000 State aid on county line bridge between Knox and Foard counties on State Highway No. 28. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Foard county be granted \$6,000 State aid on county line bridge between Knox and Foard counties on State Highway No. 28. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Comal county be granted \$25,875.19 State aid on State Highway No. 46, not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Dallas county be granted \$100,000 on State Highway No. 1, from Dallas east. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the \$31,518.62 of the \$40,000 Federal aid granted McLennan county May 20th, 1919 on Highway No. 6, and temporarily withdrawn September 20th, 1920, be reinstated and be made to apply to No. 6 between Elm Mott and West. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that McLennan county be granted \$15,000 State aid on State Highway No. 6 between Elm Mott and West. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that McLennan county be granted \$12,500 State aid on State Highway No. 7 from McGregor east. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that McLennan county be granted \$5,000 additional State aid on State Highway No. 2 from Waco to Lorena. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Comanche county be granted \$28,000 State aid on State Highway No. 10 from the Erath county line to the Brown county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Comanche county be granted \$28,469 Federal aid on State Highway No. 10 from the Erath county line to the Brown county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No. 12 be more definitely designated beginning at Wharton and paralleling as nearly as possible the G.H. & S.A. Railway to Richmond. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Wharton county be granted \$6,000 State aid on the bridge across the East Bernard River on State Highway No. 12. Motion carried.



Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Wharton county be granted \$60,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 12 from Wharton to the Jackson county line, to be applied on grading and bridging. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Tom Green county be granted \$18,000 State aid on the Lone Wolf Bridge on State Highways Nos. 9 and 4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Stonewall county be granted \$1,380.75 additional State aid on bridge over the Brazos River on State Highway No. 18, not to exceed 50 per cent, in accordance with resolution passed June 16th, 1919. Motion carried.
