Minutes of the Forty-Eighth and First Adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

W. W. McCrory, Commissioner,

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the \$35,000 Federal aid allotted to Blanco county on February 16, 1920, on Highway No. 20-A be canceled, in lieu of the \$17,500 State and \$17,500 Federal aid granted on this date. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the \$35,000 Federal aid granted to Blanco county on February 16, 1920, on State Highway No. 46, be canceled in lieu of the \$17,500 State and \$17,500 aid granted on this date. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Blanco county be granted \$17,500 State aid and \$17,500 Federal aid on State Highway No. 20-A, from a point 4.81 miles west to a point 9.01 miles south of Johnson City. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Childress county be granted \$3,780.40 State aid on State Highway No. 4, Job No. 38-A, Federal aid project No. 163, for aiding in the increase in cost to the amount of fifty per cent. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Hemphill county be granted \$2,500 State aid for the construction of a bridge over the Washita River on State Highway No. 4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Harris county be granted \$1,647.94 State aid on State Highway No. 2, Federal aid project No. 32. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Crosby county be granted \$5,525.30 State aid for the construction of bridge over the Blanco Canyon on State Highway No. 18. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Comanche county be granted \$50,000 State aid on State Highway No. 18, Erath county line to Eastland county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Comanche county be granted \$50,000 Federal aid on State Highway No. 18, Erath county line to Eastland county line. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Federal aid project No. 87, on State Highway No. 29, in Travis county, be annulled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the \$22,064.24 Federal aid on State Highway No. 29, Federal aid project No. 87, in Travis county, be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No. 14 be more definitely located through the town of Groesbeck as follows: To run east with Navasota Street from Mittenthal's Corner to William Kennedy's residence; thence south with Rusk street to intersect the old survey of right-of-way about one-half mile south of Groesbeck. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that Foard county be granted \$18,000 State aid on State Highway No. 28-A, from Crowell east to the Wilbarger county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that Shelby county be granted \$25,000 additional State aid on State Highway No. 22, for extending the gravel surfacing on this project. Motion carried.
