

February 20, 1922.

Minutes of the Fifty-sixth and First Adjourned Regular Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman,
W.W.McCrory, Commissioner,
D. K. Martin, Commissioner,
J. D. Fauntleroy, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that State Highway No.2 between San Antonio and Laredo be designated as a part of the "Jefferson Davis National Highway" in addition to those Highways officially designated on December 20th, 1920. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory seconded by Mr. Martin, that \$40,000 Federal Aid allotted to Hidalgo County on December 21, 1921 be transferred to F.A.P.250 on State Highway No.12 from Edinburg North to the Brooks County line, making a total of \$99,392.52 Federal Aid allotted to F.A.P.250 and \$160,000 Federal Aid to Highway No.12 from Cameron County line west. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Van Zandt County be granted \$6,536.62 Federal Aid and \$3,268.31 State Aid not to exceed 50% and 25%, respectively, of the cost of construction of wooden trestle and earth fill across Neches River bottom between Van Zandt and Smith Counties. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Bailey County be granted \$12,500 State Aid on State Highway No.7 from Lamb County line to Parmer County line, not to exceed 25% of cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Red River County be granted \$37,500 Federal Aid and \$18,750 State Aid not to exceed 50% and 25%, respectively, of cost of construction of State Highway No.5 beginning at Bowie County line and extending to gravel surfacing on Clarksville-English road. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Bexar County be authorized to expend \$31,000 of its share of the Motor vehicle fees for the purpose of constructing a bituminous topping on State Highway No.3. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the application of Jeff Davis County for designation of a State Highway from Alpine to Fort Davis be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Brewster for aid on State Highway #12 be filed for future consideration. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the application of Terrell County for aid on State Highway No.12 be filed for future consideration. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the application of Guadalupe County for \$45,000 additional Federal Aid for concrete curb on State Highway No.3 west of Seguin be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the application of Blanco County for \$70,500 additional Federal Aid and \$27,250.58 additional State Aid for the completion on State Highway No. 20-A be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Shelby County for \$40,695.61 additional Federal Aid on Highway No.8 between stations 614 and 911/06 and for \$32,193.11 Federal Aid on Highway No.35 between Timpson and Bobo be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the application of Shelby County for \$1,557.35 aid on State Highway No.22 between Station 0/00 and 12/64 be filed for future consideration when additional aid funds become available. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the State Highway Engineer, J. D. Pantleroy, be authorized to sign for Members of the State Highway Commission, Project Statements; Project Agreements between the State Highway Commission and the Secretary of Agriculture; vouchers for expenses and salaries of employees and resident engineers; and vouchers on monthly estimates in case of emergencies. Motion carried.
