Minutes of the Fifty-seventh and First Adjourned Regular Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building with the following members present:

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory that the following motor vehicles be declared unserviceable and that unserviceable lease agreement be issued for same thereby transferring same to the counties:

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Shelby County be granted \$1,557.35 State Aid on Highway No.22 beginning at Sta. 0/00 and extending east to Station 12/64. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Cameron County be granted \$6,751.85 State Aid on State Highway No.12 beginning at Station 923/06 and extending to station 938/30 in the town of San Benito. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Cameron County be granted \$7,097.31 State Aid on Highway No.12 beginning at South end of S.A.P.254 and extending to Elizabeth Street in Brownsville. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the application of Cameron County for \$120,000 Federal Aid on Highway No.12 West of Harlingen be filed for future consideration. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the application for designation of a State Highway beginning at Ballinger thence northwest to a connection with State Highway No.4 about 10 miles south of Sweetwater be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the designation of State Highway No.4 between San Angelo and Bronte be as follows: Beginning at San Angelo thence north to Robert Lee and thence east to Bronte. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Cass County be granted \$14,336.96 additional State Aid on Highway No.1-C, S.A.P.148 making a total of \$50,688.11 State Aid to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Atascosa County be granted \$13,000 Federal Aid and \$6,500 State Aid on State Highway No.2 from Bexar County line to Medina County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Comal County be granted \$3,581.87 State Aid on State Highway No.2 for construction of two sections beginning at Guadalupe River and extending to the I & G N railroad and beginning again at the end of city paving at South side of New Braunfels and extending South to the beginning of F.A.P.66. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that State Highway No.2 between Hutto and Austin be changed to read as follows: beginning at Hutto thence to Round Rock and thence to Austin over Highways 2-C and 2. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the following State Highways be shown as primary roads in the 7% system: (1) State Highway No.2 from Round Rock to Taylor; State Highway No.43-A from Taylor to Palestine; State Highway No.19 from Palestine to Athens; State Highway No.31 from Athens to Tyler; State Highway No.15 from Tyler to Gladewater and Highway No.11 from Gladewater to Mt. Pleasant. (2) State Highway No.2 from Burleson to Cleburne; State Highway No.2-E from Cleburne to Covington to Itasca. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Hemphill County be granted \$15,000 additional State Aid on Highway No.4 between Canadian and Lipscomb County line, conditioned upon the County's building the bridge over Washita River which is F.A.P.216. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Eastland County be granted \$50,000 State Aid for the completion of Highway No.1 between Cisco and Callahan County line and between Ranger and Palo Pinto County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Bexar County be granted \$4,500 additional Federal Aid on F.A.P.264, Job 15-B to be deducted from the \$87,745.60 Federal Aid allotted to job 15-A. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the application of Kaufman County for \$50,000 additional Federal Aid on State Highway No.15 between Van Landt County line and Forney be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that State Highway No.2-B in McLennan County be extended from Mart to the Limestone County line along what is known as the County line road. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the application for designation of State Highway beginning at Bowie, thence to Jacksboro, thence to Mineral Wells be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the \$56,907.05 Federal Aid allotted to State Highway No.34 in Tarrant County be transferred to State Highway No. 10. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Bexar County be permitted to spend \$12,000 of its motor vehicle license fees for the purpose of constructing a bituminous topping on State Highway No.3. Motion carried.
