Minutes of the Sixty-Third and First Adjourned Regular Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman
 W. W. McCrory, Commissioner,
 D. K. Martin, Commissioner,
 J. D. Fauntleroy, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Martin seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Hidalgo County be granted \$10,000.00 Federal aid on Highway No. 12 between Pharr and Mission. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Hidalgo County be granted \$10,000.00 Federal aid on Highway No. 12 between Mission and the Starr County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Rockwall County be granted \$15,000 additional State aid on Highway No. 1, F.A.P. 100, making a total of \$100,312.80 State aid to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Dallas County be granted \$22,500 State aid not to exceed 25% on Highway No. 15 between Mesquite and the Kaufman County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Travis County be granted \$3,401.00 additional State aid on Highway No. 20-A, F.A.P. 173-B, making a total of \$4,651.00 State aid to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Lavaca County be granted \$500.00 State aid not to exceed 25% of cost of bridge at Station 606/20 on Highway No. 29, F.A.P. 248. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that the \$15,000 Federal aid allotted to Nolan County on Highway No. 4 on July 18, 1922 be cancelled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Shelby County be granted \$28,073.38 Federal aid on Highway No. 35 from Joaquin to a point 3.75 miles West, to be deducted from \$73,000 granted June 19, 1922. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Matagorda County be granted \$2,627.45 additional State aid on State Highway No. 12-C, F.A.P. 175, making a total of \$5,651.87 State aid to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the \$30,000.00 Federal aid allotted on August 21st, 1922 to LaSalle County on bridge over Neches River at Cotulla be cancelled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Brewster County be granted \$150,000 Federal aid not to exceed 50% on Highway No. 12 from County line to County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Rains County be granted \$16,000 State aid not to exceed 50% of cost of constructing a bituminous surface treatment on State Highway No. 42, F.A.P. 153. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that that portion of the Jefferson Davis Highway West of Alpine as officially designated on December 20, 1920 be changed to read as follows: Beginning at Alpine, thence to Fort Davis, thence to Balmorhea, thence to Kent and thence over State Highway No. 1 to El Paso. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Houston County be granted \$16,708.21 additional Federal aid and \$8,354.10 additional State aid on Highway No. 21 from east end of F.A.P. 254 to Crockett. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Liberty County be granted \$64,800 additional Federal aid and \$32,400 additional State aid to Highway No. 3 for grading and bridges from county line to county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the \$300,000.00 State and Federal aid heretofore allotted on 10 miles of Highway No. 3 in Liberty County be amended to read as follows: That \$100,000 State aid and \$200,000 Federal aid be granted to Liberty County to be expended on grading and drainage structures on Highway No. 3 from county line to county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Comal County be granted \$5,000.00 additional State aid on Highway No. 46, F.A.P. 246. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the application of Brooks County for 75% aid for the reconstruction of Highway No. 12 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. McCrory, that Highway No. 19-A between Angleton and Bay City be more definitely designated as follows: Beginning at Angleton, thence west to Columbia, and thence to Bay City. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. McCrory, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the following list of trucks, motorcycles, and equipment be declared unserviceable and that unserviceable lease agreements for same be issued thereby transferring the title from the State Highway Department to the counties:
