Minutes of the Seventy-second and First Adjourned Meeting of the State Highway Commission held in the State Office Building with the following members present:

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Bailey County be granted \$5,500 State Aid for the purpose of completing the sand clay surfacing on State Highway No.7 conditioned that this allotment of aid does not approve the location of present road between Muleshoe and Sedan or any part of it as the final location of State Highway No.7 in Bailey County. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Bee County for aid on State Highway No.12-B beginning at Beeville and extending east to the Goliad County line be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Bexar County be granted \$8633.73 State Aid on F.A.P. 239. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Bexar County be granted \$10,063 Additional Federal Aid and \$5,031.50 additional State Aid on F.A.P. 264. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Bowie County be granted \$2,500 additional Federal and \$1,250.00 additional state aid to F.A.P. 268 (Hubbard Bridge). Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Cass County be granted \$2,500 additional Federal Aid and \$1,250 additional State Aid on F.A.P. 268 (Hubbard Bridge). Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Bowie County be granted \$3,000 Federal Aid not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of constructing the bridge on F.A.P. 268 which was at first planned to be left in place. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Bowie County be granted \$9,000 additional State Aid to F.A.P. 313 on Highway No.1. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Brooks County be granted \$7,000 additional Federal Aid and \$6,300 additional State Aid to F.A.P. 278 on State Highway No.12, making a total of \$71,000 Federal Aid and \$25,300 State Aid allotted to this project, conditioned upon Brooks County setting aside \$46,000 of its funds. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Coleman County for \$9,000 Federal Aid for the construction of the bituminous topping on State Highway No.7 beginning at Coleman and extending to F.A.P. 303 be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Deaf Smith County for \$10,000 State Aid to be used for the purpose of constructing the pavement on State Highway No.33 through the City of Hereford be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Denton County be granted \$22,000 State Aid not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of constructing 6.75 miles of state highway No.39, beginning at Little Elm Creek and extending to the Collin County Line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Denton County be granted \$32,000 State Aid not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of the constructing of 8.5 miles of State Highway No.39 beginning at the Wise County line and extending east. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the \$100,000 Federal Aid allotted on June 19, 1922 to Falls County on State Highway No.44 in the Rosebud District be cancelled, and in lieu thereof that \$44,500 Federal Aid and \$48,500 State Aid be granted to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Fannin County be granted \$3,388 additional state aid to F.A.P. 322 on State Highway No.5. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Fannin County be granted \$5,190 additional State Aid on F.A.P. 344, State Highway No.5. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Fayette County be granted \$75,250 Federal Aid on State Highway No. 3-D beginning at LaGrange and extending to the Colorado County Line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Frio County be granted \$11,741.76 additional Federal Aid to Section A and \$40,031.26 additional Federal Aid to Section B, F.A.P. 273 on Highway No.2. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Grayson County be granted \$5,000 additional State Aid to F.A.P. No.292 on State Highway No.2 conditioned upon the construction of the underpass at Bells. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Guadalupe County be granted \$8,029.38 additional State Aid to Section A of F.A.P. 155 on State Highway No.3. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Guadalupe County be granted \$664.00 additional State Aid on Section B of F.A.P. 155 on State Highway No.3. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Guadalupe County be granted \$5,000 additional Federal Aid and \$2,500 additional State Aid on Section B of F.A.P. 35 on State Highway No. 3 east of Seguin, for the purpose of widening the present gravel surfacing to 18' and adding additional depth of gravel to the present surfacing. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Hill County for Federal Aid for the construction of a 16' gravel surfacing one mile in length in the town of Whitney on State Highway No.22 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Jasper County be granted \$20,000 additional Federal Aid to F.A.P. 317 on State Highway No.7 making a total of \$85,500 Federal Aid allotted to this project and is not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of construction. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the present allotment of \$110,250 Federal Aid to F.A.P. No.349 in Jefferson County on State No.40 ( Voth Road) be reduced to \$60,265.20. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Jefferson County be granted \$90,984.80 additional federal aid on F.A.P. 328, State Highway No.3, Neches River Bridge. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Johnson County for \$29,625.77 Federal Aid on State Highway No.10-A between Cleburne and the Ellis County line be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Lamar County be granted \$30,000 additional Federal Aid for the purpose of completing a concrete pavement on Highway No.5 east of Paris and constructing three additional miles of concrete pavement on Highway No.5 west of Paris. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Liberty County for \$14,063.00 Federal Aid on State Highway No.35 from Cleveland north to the San Jacinto County line be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Mason County be granted \$23,500 Federal Aid and \$11,750 State Aid on State Highway No.9 beginning at the Mason County Line and extending north 4.7 miles. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Menard County for Federal Aid on State Highway No.30 beginning at Menard and extending to the Kimble County Line be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Nolan County for \$10,000 State Aid for the purpose of constructing .4 of a mile of pavement on State Highway No.1 within the city limits of Roscoe be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Nueces County for Federal Aid on State Highway No.12-A Robstown-Alice Road be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Palo Pinto County be granted \$50,000 Federal Aid not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of constructing the surfacing on six miles of State Highway No.28. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Palo Pinto County be granted \$52,000 Additional Federal Aid on Section B of F.A.P. 294 on State Highway No.1 between Mineral Wells and the Parker County lines conditioned upon the construction of a brick pavement on this section of Highway No.1. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Parmer County be granted \$5,500 State Aid on State Highway No.33 beginning at Farwell and extending to the Castro County Line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Parmer County be granted \$10,000 State Aid on State Highway No.7 conditioned upon the location of this Highway being satisfactory to this department. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Red River County be granted \$4,000 additional State Aid to F.A.P. 311, Job 194-C on State Highway No.5 in the English-Avery Road District. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Reeves County for fifty percent Federal Aid and fifty percent State Aid for the construction of the remaining fifteen miles of State Highway No.27 between Toyahvale and the connection with State Highway No.1 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Stephens County be granted \$214,594.00 additional Federal Aid and \$7,629.20 additional State Aid to Section B of F.A.P. 199 on State Highway No.1 conditioned upon the construction of a 2" asphaltic concrete pavement on the 15.82 miles, beginning at Station 230 and extending to the Palo Pinto County line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Stonewall County be granted \$800.00 State Aid not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of replacing the washed-out pier on the bridge over the Salt Fort of the Brazos River in Stonewall County on State Highway No.18. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Sutton County be granted \$175,000 additional Federal Aid on State Highway No.4 south of Sonora and State Highway No.27 east of Sonora. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Tom Green County be granted \$7,096.36 State Aid for the construction of the 12 mile bridge on State Highway No.7 over the South Concho River. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Tom Green County be granted \$37,096.42 additional Federal Aid on Section B of F.A.P. 116 on State Highway No.4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Tom Green County be granted \$16531.35 additional State Aid on Section B of S.A.P. No.141 on State Highway No.4. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Tom Green County be granted \$32,338.68 Federal Aid on State Highway No.9 beginning at the west end of F.A.P. No.145 and extending west 9.71 miles to Sanatorium. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Uvalde County be granted \$25,000 <sup>Federal Aid</sup> not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of constructing State Highway No.3-E beginning at Uvalde and extending to the Zavalla County Line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Webb County be granted \$150,000 Federal Aid and \$50,000 State Aid to State Highway No.12-A for the purpose of completing this Highway between Laredo and the Jim Wells County Line, with a bituminous topping, and conditioned upon Webb County voting a \$100,000 in bonds for this work. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Wichita County be granted \$90,000 Federal Aid not to exceed fifty percent of the cost of constructing six miles of State Highway No.30. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Williamson County be granted \$3,000 State Aid for the purpose of replacing the approaches and the floor to the present bridge over the San Gabriel River on State Highway No.2-C, just north of Georgetown. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Williamson County be granted \$44,178.50 Federal Aid and \$22,089.25 State Aid on State Highway No.2 beginning at the west end of F.A.P. No.266 and extending 6.5 miles to Round Rock conditioned upon the location of this highway between Hutto and Round Rock being on the north side of the I and G. N. Railroad the entire distance and further conditioned upon the construction of an underpass over the M. K. and T. railroad. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Karnes County for extending State Highway No.12-B from Kenedy to Campbellton to Dilley be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Panola County for the relocation of State Highway No.8 between Marshall and Carthage be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Madison, Leon, Robertson and Brazos Counties for the relocation of State Highway No.21 between Bryan and the Trinity River along what is known as the old San Antonio Road be not granted. Motion granted.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that State Highway No.21 from Giddings, to Waelder be cancelled. Motion carried. ✓

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No.44 be extended from Giddings in Lee County to LaGrange in Fayette County. Motion carried. ✓

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Dimmitt County for designated State Highway beginning at Eagle Pass and extending through Carrizo Springs to connection with Highway No. 2 at Dilley be postponed, pending investigation by the Division Engineer. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Grimes County for a designated highway beginning at Huntsville and extending to Roanes Prairie, Anderson, Navasota and thence to Brenham be postponed pending investigation by the Division Engineer. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the following list of war equipment be declared unserviceable and that unserviceable lease agreements for same be issued thereby transferring the title from the State Highway Department to the County or City:
