

October 15, 1923.

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Minutes of the seventy-third and first Adjourned Meeting of the State Highway Commission held in the State Office building with the following members present:

R.M. Hubbard, Chairman,  
D.K. Martin, State Highway Commissioner,  
George D. Armistead, State Highway Commissioner,  
J.D. Fauntleroy, State Highway Engineer.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Bexar County be granted \$66,220.88 Federal Aid and \$33,110.44 State Aid on Highway No. 3 west of San Antonio. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Bexar County be granted \$58,538.58 Federal Aid and \$18,846.18 State Aid to Highway No. 3 east of San Antonio, F.A.P. 398. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Brazoria County be granted \$74,400 State Aid to F.A.P. 367 on Highway No. 19. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Brooks County be granted \$375,000 Federal Aid and \$125,000 State Aid to Highway No. 12 from Falfurrias south to Hidalgo County line, conditioned upon Brooks County putting up \$250,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Coleman County be granted \$4000.00 State Aid on Highway No. 7-A, beginning at Coleman and extending south to connection with F.A.P. 303. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Donley County be granted \$5000.00 State Aid not to exceed 50% of cost of bridge over Salt Fork of Brazos River on Highway No. 88. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Falls County be granted \$5,216.66 State Aid on F.A.P. 297. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Fayette County for \$20,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 3, F.A.P. 37 be not granted.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Grimes County for \$45,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 45 from Roans Prairie to Walker County line be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Guadalupe County for 2/3 State and Federal Aid on Highway No. 3 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Harris County be granted \$225,000 State Aid for reconstruction of bridges on State Highway in Harris County not to exceed fifty percent. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Harrison County be granted \$74,275.00 State Aid for reconstruction of 16.3 miles of State Highway No. 15. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Karnes County be granted \$40,000 additional Federal Aid on F.A.P. 266 Highway No. 9, for purpose of constructing a water bound macadam 6" compacted thickness. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that McLennan County be granted \$20,646.00 State Aid for the relocation of 1.5 miles of Highway No. 2 near Bruceville. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Shelby County be granted \$23,635.75 additional State Aid to Job 210-E. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the aid allotted to Tarrant County on Highway No.10, F.A.P. 301, be increased to \$75,000 Federal Aid and \$25,000 State Aid. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Johnson and Parker County be granted \$53,416 State and Federal Aid on 6.13 miles of Highway No.10. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Tom Green County for \$44,594.44 additional Federal Aid on F.A.P. 412 be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Val Verde County for \$100,000 Federal Aid and \$40,000 State Aid for completing Highway No.3 be not granted.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Highway No.91 be designated as follows: Beginning at Denison and extending northwest to Preston. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Highway No.34 between Kaufman and Ennis be reinstated conditioned upon location between these two points being satisfactory, that all railroad grade crossings be eliminated and that the highway be turned over to the State Highway Department on January 1, 1924 with all grading completed on the new location. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Brazos County for the reinstatement of the old designation of Highway No.45 from Huntsville to Bryan via Bedias be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Brazos County for extending Highway No.45 from Bryan to Caldwell to Page be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the designation of Highway No.8 between Carthage and Marshall be postponed pending further investigations by the Division Engineer. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Highway No. 19 between Angleton and Galveston be temporarily located to go via Alvin. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application for reinstatement of Highway No.3-C be postponed pending recommendations by the Division Engineer. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Guadalupe County for a State Highway from San Marcos to Sutherland Springs via Seguin be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Hamilton County for a designated State Highway from Stephenville to Lampasas via Hamilton be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the change in location of Highway No.30 between Seymour and Wichita Falls be postponed pending investigations by the Division Engineer. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Travis County for reinstatement of Highway No.2 via Pflugerville be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Palo Pinto County for change in present designation of Highway No.28 between Mineral Wells and Jacksboro be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Tarrant County be granted \$20,000 retroactive State Aid on S.A.P. 242 on Highway No. 1 (F.A.P. 42). Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Hall County for \$200,000 Federal Aid on Highway No.18 be postponed. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the following list of equipment be declared unserviceable and that unserviceable lease agreements for same be issued, thereby transferring title from State to the counties and Cities.
