

January 21, 1924.

Minutes of the Seventy-Sixth and First Adjourned Meeting of the State Highway Commission held in the State Office Building with the following members present:

- R.M. Hubbard, Chairman,
- D.K. Martin, State Highway Commissioner,
- George D. Armistead, State Highway Commissioner
- J.D. Fauntleroy, State Highway Engineer.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Cass County be granted \$220,500 Federal Aid and \$73,500 State Aid on Highway No. 8 from Douglassville south to the Marion County line, contingent upon Cass County voting \$147,000 in bonds for the improvement of this highway. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Falls County be granted \$4,546.13 additional State Aid to F.A.P. 331-A on Highway No. 44. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Fort Bend County be granted \$150,000 Federal Aid and \$50,000 State Aid to the Richmond Bridge F.A.P. 334 which allotment includes the present aid to this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Fort Bend County be granted \$25,000 additional State Aid to F.A.P. 326 on Highway No. 3. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the \$800,000 State and Federal Aid allotted to Hunt County be apportioned as follows: \$161,723.55 Federal Aid and \$112,914.13 State Aid to F.A.P. 171; \$106,914.35 Federal Aid and \$19,297.70 State Aid to F.A.P. 188; \$68,499.49 Federal Aid and \$53,028.03 State Aid to F.A.P. 189; \$40,530.94 Federal Aid and \$24,513.26 to F.A.P. 190; \$15,112.00 State Aid for increase in cost of gravel on the four Federal Aid Projects; \$24,250.00 State Aid to the Commerce Sulphur Springs road; \$52,500 State Aid to the Floyd Road, Highway No. 39; and \$7270.90 State Aid to be held to meet overruns on any of the above mentioned projects. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Jefferson County be granted \$115,000 State Aid to F.A.P. 312 on Highway No. 3 Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Orange County be granted \$116,000 State Aid to the Neches River bridge F.A.P. 328. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Jones County be granted \$200,000 State Aid, not to exceed 50% on Highway No. 83. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Kerr County for \$86,000 additional State Aid to Highway No. 27 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Liberty County for \$30,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 61 from Devers to Chambers County line be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of McLennan county for \$50,000 additional Federal Aid to F.A.P. 265, Highway No. 7 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Mitchell County be granted \$5,207.34 State Aid not to exceed 50% of cost of constructing 1485 feet of Highway No. 1 between Lone Wolf Bridge and Colorado River Bridge. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that nueces County be granted \$46,345.56 additional State Aid to R.A.P. 340, 341 and 342. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Potter County be granted \$13,073.00 State Aid on 1.05 miles of Highway No.33 in the western edge of Amarillo. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Williamson County for \$35,000 additional Federal Aid on Highway No.74 be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Wise County for \$55,279.40 State Aid on 8.2 miles of Highway No. 39 be filed for future consideration. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of DeWitt County for a designated Highway from Cuero via Yorktown to Stockdale be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Cameron County for a designated Highway from Harlingen to Wilacy be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Highway No. 64 between Carthage and Henderson be not designated by way of Clayton. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Kunnels County for a designated highway from Ballinger to Sweetwater be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Hill County for a designated State Highway from Hillsboro to connection with Highway No.31 at Hubbard city be not granted.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that a highway No.93 be designated as follows: Beginning at Gatesville and extending north to the State Reformatory School. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Hays County for the reinstatement of Highway No.29-A from San Marcos to Wimberley be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Callahan County that Highway No.23 be redesignated via Cross Plains to Putman be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Jones County for a designated State Highway from Stamford via Hamlin to Rotan be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No.74 between San Saba and Goldthwaite be cancelled and in lieu thereof that this Highway be designated from San Saba to Lometa. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that State Highway No.42 from Alba to Mineola be cancelled and in lieu thereof that this highway be designated from Alba to Quitman. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that State Highway No.43 from Leander to Round Rock be cancelled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Highway No. 29 be extended from Austin to Leander and that the Highway from Leander via Bertram, Burnett, Llano to Mason be hereafter known as Highway No.29. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Karnes County be granted \$10,000 Federal Aid on Highway No.9, beginning at the north end of R.A.P. 266 and extending north 9 miles. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that the application of Erath county for a designated State Highway from Stephenville to Thurber be not granted. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Colorado county for \$435,860.00 State and Federal Aid on 21 miles of Highway No.3 be postponed for future consideration. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Guadalupe County be granted \$81,026.43 additional Federal Aid and \$27,008.81 additional State Aid to R.A.P. 35 for construction of bituminous top on this project. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that the application of Polk County for \$3750000 State Aid on bridges on Highway No.45 be not granted. Motion carried.
