Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission as taken from the Open Hearing Minutes of March 16, 1925:

Designation of road from Lampasas to Rosebud via Killeen, Belton, and Temple granted. (Lampasas, Bell and Falls Counties.)

Request for re-designation of Highway No. 10 from Denton northeast to County line, via Aubrey and Pilot Point, granted on condition that road be put in good condition, this includes the graveling from Tioga south to County line. (Denton County.)

Request for designation of extension of Highway No. 55 from La Pryor to point near Cactus on State Highway No. 2 granted on condition that bonds are voted. (Dimmit and Webb Counties.)

Request for designation from Gonzales, Gonzales County, to Karnes City, Karnes County, via Nixon, Gillett and Helena granted on condition that counties provide bonds.

Jasper County granted \$60,000.00 for use on Highway No. 62, from Buna to the Newton County line, 12.5 miles. Jasper County has available for this highway \$40,000.00.

Jim Hogg County granted \$15,000.00 additional aid on Highway No. 12-A from Corpus Christi to Laredo, on a distance of 10.2 miles.

Kimball and Mason County: Designation granted from Mason to Rock Springs, via Junction, London and Telegraph on condition bonds are voted within twelve months.

Lampasas, Hamilton and Erath Counties: Designation from Thurber to Lampasas by Stephenville, Hico, Hamilton and Evant granted, on the condition that the road is put into shape and passes inspection of engineers.

Tarrant and Jack Counties: Designation from Fort Worth to Jacksboro granted if same is financed within a year.
